## Chappie Hall Scholarship Fund and Other Scholarships

Thirteen thousand dollars in scholarships were awarded at the 62nd Annual Reunion to nine outstanding scholars—six thousand more dollars awarded in 2007 than in 2006. This was made possible because of the efforts of our members and friends. There were thirty-two applicants for the scholarships; twenty-three deserving students were unable to obtain assistance from us because we only had enough funds to award \$13,000 this year.

The Chappie Hall Scholarship Fund provides scholarship assistance from the earned income each year. The more money there is in the fund, the more money there is available to award to deserving students. This year's scholarships also included BG Donald F. Pratt Memorial Fund Scholarship, the Jack Browder Memorial Scholarship, the Scott Vallely Memorial Fund Scholarship and the Ed Knapp Family Scholarship.

You can help! Wouldn't it be wonderful for the 101st Airborne Division Association Chappie Hall Scholarship Fund to be able to award more scholarships each year? It's not going to happen overnight, but it can happen over a period of time. We will have an additional scholarship next year, the Al and Willamary Viste Scholarship.
